

**Sonia Antinori** is an Italian playwright, actress and theatre director working in Italy and abroad since 1990. Her plays have been presented at several festivals, theaters, broadcasted and translated into German, English, French, Spanish etc. She has won several awards *Premio Tondelli* (1993), *Premio Riccione* (1995), *Mravac Award of the International Theater Festival in Mostar - Bosnia* (1997) *Premio Candoni Arta Terme* (1998), *Premio Valeria Moriconi* (2011). She has translated many plays from German and English into Italian (A.Schnitzler, F.Wedekind, Ö.von Horvath, K.Specht, W.Schwab, Th.Wilder, R.Munro, M.Rose, G.Büchner, M.Bertholet, F.Kater, E.O'Neill, D.Loher). In 2007 her Italian version of the play *Volksvernichtung* by Austrian playwright Werner Schwab has been awarded with the most prestigious Italian Theatre Prize: *Premio Ubu* in Milan.

She taught playwriting at Scuola Holden directed by Alessandro Baricco in Turin, CUT -University of Venice, University of Urbino, Scuola Teatri Possibili in Milan, School of Teatro Stabile delle Marche in Ancona. In 2012 Titivillus published her first plays' collection: *4. Trame agli angoli della Storia*. She is WISE Project Artistic Director.
